PUBLIC NOTICE

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the undersigned, Pierre Vaillancourt, Director general and Secretary Treasurer of the said municipality, concerning the burning By-law 05-2012 in force in the Municipality of Kazabazua, we remind you that these steps should be followed to burn safely

Steps to burn safely



To avoid any risk, the municipality recommends composting, picking green waste or depositing waste in an ecocentre in your area. If these options are not available, here are the steps to follow.

STEP 1: CONSULT THE MUNICIPAL BY-LAW

- Make sure you are in compliance with the By-law and obtain the required permits.

STEP 2: CONFIRM THAT CONDITIONS ARE GOOD FOR BURNING

- To inquire about the fire danger and the restrictions issued by SOPFEU. Burn only when the danger is low or moderate.
- Ensure that climatic conditions are conducive to burning, high humidity and low winds. Favor the evening since the risk of spread is higher between 1 pm and 6 pm

STEP 3: AT THE MOMENT OF BURNING

- Choose a place away from buildings or wooded areas and clean it by removing all plant material from it.
- Make small clusters (maximum 1 meter by 1 meter) and light one at a time.
- Stay on site and constantly monitor the burning.

- Extinguish the fire completely before leaving the area.
