

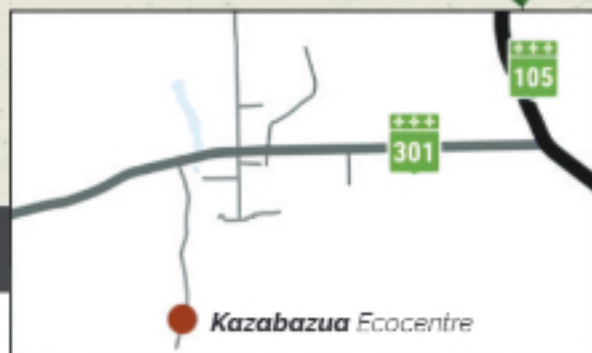

PRICING FOR MATERIALS	
MINIMUM \$6 PER VISIT	
Concrete <i>Reinforced or not</i>	\$30 / ton
"Natural" wood and branches <i>Such as: timber, plywood, particle board, branches</i>	\$50 / ton
Roofing shingles <i>Separate from other construction materials</i>	\$80 / ton
Organic material <i>Food waste, meat, etc.</i>	\$90 / ton
Construction materials <i>Such as: gyproc, vinyl siding, pressure treated wood, painted or stained wood</i>	\$140 / ton
Oversized garbage <i>Such as: mattress, table, sofa, etc.</i>	\$170 / ton
Oversized tires, damaged tires or tires with rims <i>Greater than 123.19 cm (48.5") in diameter</i>	\$0.20 / kg
	<i>Greater than 335 cm (132") in diameter</i>
Very big garbage <i>Such as: boat, trailer, big concrete slab</i>	\$170 / ton + \$100 fixed fee

MATERIALS ACCEPTED FREE OF CHARGE



Metals

Such as: Ferrous and non-ferrous metal, home appliances, propane cylinders of 20 lbs capacity or more

Electronics

Domestic electronics such as: Office computers, laptops, notebooks, e-book readers, cell phones, televisions, printers scanners, photocopiers, fax machines, keyboards, mouse, cables, remotes, etc.
Excludes commercial floor-fixed equipment

Yard Waste

Leaves and grass cuttings (no plastic bags)

Tires without rims (including damaged tires)

Car and truck tires < 123.19 cm (48.5")

Single use small propane cylinders

Usually for camping use, green in colour

COMING SOON: Dangerous domestic waste

Such as: paint, oil, oil filters and used oil containers; aerosols and lubricants; used batteries; compact fluorescent lightbulbs, neon tubes; all other organic or inorganic household hazardous waste.

WASTE NOT ACCEPTED AT THE ECOCENTRE



Contaminated soil, garbage from outside the province of Quebec, animal carcasses, biomedical waste, sludge, manure and slurry, radioactive waste, PCB and cyanide, munitions and fireworks.
